Good morning Dawn

I hope you are well. I realise this comes very late in the process but we have recently been in correspondence with [REDACTED], the local Wetland Bird Survey Recorder for the area around Grangemouth, who has a huge amount of knowledge of the area. On Saturday, I received an email from him -supported by two local ornithologists of note [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] – to say that it was his view that the measures being suggested as compensation for impacts on the Firth of Forth Special Protection Area are not only unnecessary but may adversely impact the site. Is there any way this important information might be included in the hearing process?

It is worth noting that throughout the development of the proposed Scheme, we had suggested to Falkirk Council that they should consult [REDACTED] because of his local knowledge but this did not take place and it was RSPB Scotland who solicited his views.
