The **Grangemouth Flood Protection Scheme** (GFPS) will be holding a series of engagement events in late February and early March before the scheme moves forward to Scheme Notification.

Proceeding to Statutory Notification was approved by Falkirk Council's Executive Committee on 16 January 2024.

These are the **final engagement events** before Falkirk Council commences the Scheme Notification process in Spring 2024.

These events are for anyone who is affected by or interested in the flood scheme. You'll be able to look at the final design and pose questions to our experts first-hand.

There is an option to attend either in-person or online engagement events, and a full schedule, giving times and locations, can be found on the back page.

There will be the opportunity to ask questions at both the in-person and online sessions. For those that can't attend the in-person or online events, there will also be a virtual exhibition.

This virtual exhibition will show the same information that will be available at the in-person and online engagement events.

Alistair Dawson, Infrastructure Projects Manager, said: "I would encourage everyone affected by the flood scheme, or those who are interested in it, to make sure they visit one of the engagement events or go to our virtual exhibition for full information. It's important that everyone understands the impact the scheme might have on them or their property, and how they can make comment or take part in the statutory process."
